Qualification Requirements	Applicants must be able to start working from the above starting date, and must meet all the following eligibility requirements:  (1) Must have at least a master's degree at the time of application with a relevant research field.  (2) Must have three or more years of experience in teaching English to Japanese university students. Must be passionate about education and research and be willing to actively participate in the operational affairs of our English language program.  (3) Must have native or near-native proficiency in English. (Applicants who are non-native speakers of Japanese should have an adequate command of Japanese to perform administrative duties.)  *Those who have been employed with Ritsumeikan Trust on a fixed-term contract for six or more consecutive years immediately preceding the academic year before starting this position are not eligible to apply.
