The IB education department at Ritsumeikan Uji High School is looking for an open-minded and proactive qualified teacher to join a dynamic group of educators. The ideal candidate is an experienced social studies teacher who can work both independently on a day-to-day basis and also collaboratively with other teachers to ensure a high standard of instruction in the department.

The position is ideally for an IBDP Social Studies teacher, with a background or familiarity with Business Management for students aged 16-18, and with the ability to teach General Social Studies for the 12-15 age range. Experience in Business Management would be an advantage, however is not strictly required for the position.

The successful candidate will be expected to teach up to 15 classes per week, on average, where each class is 50 minutes long. Teachers are also asked to assist with extra-curricular activities and develop their own opportunities for students based on personal interests and hobbies.

We are a relatively small IB program in a much larger school with small class sizes and access to large amounts of resources. Teachers at Ritsumeikan Uji are empowered to create, innovate, and personalize a learning environment in a way that suits their teaching style and allows them to develop their own professional approach. Departmental meetings and school-sponsored professional development give teachers opportunities to share good practice and grow. This is an excellent opportunity for any professionally minded teacher to develop their teaching skills in a welcoming environment in the suburban outcrop of one of the most beautiful cities in Japan.

4. Requirements and Preferences

- 1) Speaks English as a first language or demonstrates equivalent ability.
- 2) Holds a valid Japanese VISA (preferred)
- 3) Applicants must be able to teach Higher Level Diploma classes in Business Management as well as junior high school general Social Studies. The ability to teach other IB subjects will be considered a bonus.
- 4) At a minimum, applicants must hold an undergraduate degree in the study of Social Studies, or hold an undergraduate degree comprising units in a range of Social Studies subjects such as History, Business, Economics, Politics, Geography, or Civics.
- 5) Applicants are expected to hold an official IB certificate (in-person or online) in an IB Social Studies subject such as Business Management or Economics. - 6) Applicants with recognized teaching certification are preferred. Successful applicants will also be required to obtain Japanese high school teaching certification. The school will advise the applicant and assist with this.
