However, not all of the aforementioned classes may be assigned.</p>

Qualification Requirements	<p>Applicants must meet all of the following eligibility requirements and must be able to start working from the above starting date:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (1) Ph.D. degree or equivalent research achievements. (2) Ability to conduct classes in English and Japanese. Besides conveying expert knowledge, it is expected to flexibly accommodate the needs of our undergraduate and graduate students and to deliver lectures on basic knowledge of Constitutional Law. (3) Willingness to contribute to administrative duties in Japanese language at the university.

9. Affiliation · Workplace	<p>College of International Relations, Ritsumeikan University Kinugasa Campus (Kyoto Prefecture) *There is a possibility that you might be in charge of subjects opened in Biwako-Kusatsu campus (Shiga Prefecture), Osaka Ibaraki campus (Osaka Prefecture)</p>
